

HEAVY VEHICLE PRE-TRIP INSPECTION:

Exterior inspection:

Approaching vehicle:

1. There are no leakages or obstructions underneath the vehicle.
2. The water, oil, brake fluid and fanbelt has been checked and is OK.
3. This door can open from the inside and outside and the window can wind up and down.
4. This mirror is clean and undamaged.
5. The tread of the tyre is correct.
6. The sidewall of the tyre is undamaged.
7. The pressure of the tyre is correct.
8. The wheelnuts have been checked and are fastened.
9. The dust cap is on.
10. The whole windscreen is clean and undamaged.
11. Both the wipers are clean and undamaged (lift wipers up).
12. All headlights, parking lights and indicator lights are clean and undamaged.
13. This mirror is clean and undamaged.
14. This wheel will be checked the same as the right-hand front wheel.
15. This door will be checked the same as the right-hand front door.
16. The cab locking mechanism is secure (only if applicable).
17. The flap is secure (only if applicable).
18. The fuel tank is checked and has a fuel cap on.
19. Both these wheels will be checked the same as the right-hand front wheel.
20. There are no objects between the two wheels.
21. The tailgate is secure (only if applicable).
22. The chevron is undamaged and secure.
23. All the taillights are clean and undamaged.
24. The spare wheel will be checked the same as the right-hand front wheel.
25. Both these wheels are checked the same as the right-hand front wheel.
26. There are no objects between the two wheels.
27. The side flap is secure (only if applicable).
28. The battery is undamaged and secure.
29. The air reservoir is secure and has no leaks (only if applicable).
30. All reflector tape are clean and undamaged.

Interior inspection:

1. All the doors are closed.
2. The parking brake is "ON".
3. The vehicle is in "NEUTRAL".
4. There are no obstructions at my feet.
5. My seat is correct.
6. The mirrors are correct.

The following will be checked for working condition

1. Indicator lights.
2. Parking lights and head lights.
3. Wipers.
4. Hooter.
5. Brake and taillights.

As soon as testing officer enters vehicle, applicant to ask him if his door is securely closed and to mention that the driver door is also securely closed.

MOVE OFF (while checking into side mirrors)

FULL OBSERVATION (BLINDSPOT (over shoulder) -
MIRROR - MIRROR – BLINDSPOT (over shoulder))
(STARTING FROM OPPOSITE SIDE)

MOVE OFF (WHILE CHECKING INTO SIDE MIRROR)

STARTING PROCEDURE

(AFTER COMPLETING THE YARD TEST AND BEFORE
THE ROAD TEST)

1. Ensure that the parking brake is on.
2. Ensure that the gear is in neutral.
3. Check that all gauges and warning lights are in non-function position.
4. Turn ignition key to "on" position.
5. Check dashboard warning lights and gauges for malfunction.
6. Apply choke if necessary or ensure that choke is cancelled.
7. Turn ignition key further to start engine.
7. Check dashboard warning lights and gauges for system malfunction.
8. Apply brake to ensure that brake pressure is correct.
